POWER52 ENERGY INSTITUTE

ENERGY PROFESSIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM



Power52 Foundation has created a successful model for training residents from historically marginalized communities to participate in Maryland's booming clean energy economy. Power52's training brings workforce development, resiliency, and clean energy solutions to lowand medium-income communities. The curriculum we teach is based

on the solar/clean energy industry. Students learn to install solar panels and electrical systems, with at least 20% of the training being hands on in our lab. **Our workforce development programs recognize that job training alone does not ensure a successful career, especially for individuals who have not had the opportunity to participate in the workforce in skilled positions in the past.**



Our training programs includes extensive case management throughout the program and for twelve months after graduation, to ensure that individuals employed through the program receive the support they need to be successful. In addition, the curriculum includes "soft skills" training to develop competencies such as professional work habits and appearance, time

management, conflict management and problem solving. Ultimately, the training programs yield marketable skills and credentials for success in an industry that has significant need for skilled workers and pays a living wage.
